



CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Arts Council of Wilmington & New Hanover County invites sculptors to submit proposals for its Pedestrian Art public sculpture program. Artists or artist teams may submit up to six sculptures for consideration. The deadline for consideration is October 15, 2020 with installation scheduled for mid-November 2020.

Specifications

- Be of high artistic quality
- Be capable of withstanding adverse weather conditions including high winds, high temperatures, heavy rain, storms, etc.
- Demonstrate structural soundness, safety and stability for an unsupervised general audience
- Be maintenance-free during the exhibition period
- Fit into an urban setting
- Be structurally secured to existing 4' x 4' concrete pad with anchor bolts or similar devices

Timeline

- Submissions are due on October 15, 2020.
- Notifications will be made by October 31, 2020.
- Artwork will be installed mid-November 2020.

Stipend

The artist will be awarded \$750 per sculpture (\$500 after installation and \$250 on removal). This award is all-inclusive, i.e. the artist is responsible for transportation, installation and de-installation of the artwork. Any additional costs are the responsibility of the artist.

Insurance

The Arts Council of Wilmington assumes no liability for damage or theft of the artwork. The artist shall decide whether to insure their artwork.

Purchases

Artists may sell the work(s) during the exhibition period, however, the work(s) must remain on site for the duration of the exhibition. The Arts Council of Wilmington & NHC shall receive 30% commission on the sale of the exhibited artwork.

Promotion

Arts Council of Wilmington & NHC will provide signage to identify the artwork which will be featured on the Arts Council of Wilmington's website and included in promotional materials.

How to Submit

Entrants should email the following to info@artswilmington.org with the subject line of **Pedestrian Art** no later than October 15, 2020.

- Completed, signed application
- Artist statement
- Artist resume or CV
- Digital images of completed or artist's renderings of work in progress. Images should be submitted in JPEG or PNG format. You may submit up to six sculptures, 1-2 views of each.
- Optional PDF file of additional support material, including press clippings or other relevant information on past projects (maximum 1MB file.)

Digital Specifications

- Pixel dimensions per image: approximately 600 x 800
- Image resolution: 72-300 pixels per inch
- Maximum file size per image: 1MB
- Name each image: lastnamefirstnameimagenumber.jpg, for example: doejane 01, doejane02,doejane03, etc.
- A corresponding, numbered, annotated image list with title, media, dimensions, location, brief description, date of the work, and project partners, if applicable.
- Please send images as attachments and not in the body of the email.
